- Most recent transcript covering last full year of school. Include current year's grades from most recent semester or quarter. Photocopies of report cards are acceptable. (As requested on Masonic Lodge Scholarship page). **Required task.**
- List and briefly describe awards and/or extracurricular and community service activities. (As requested on Masonic Lodge Scholarship page). **Required task.**
- Copies of American College Testing (ACT) and/or Scholastic Aptitude Testing (SAT), or other entrance examination scores / information as applicable and if available. **Preferred task, not required.**

If you wish to have any of the items returned please note which item(s) and provide a self-addressed and stamped envelope capable of receiving the item(s) and ensuring their acceptance and delivery by the postal service.
