Requirements for the Scholarship

1. Applicants for the scholarships must live in the Frankfort Community High School district.
2. Applicants for the scholarship must have a well-rounded high school career, having the ability to achieve goals or potential success.
3. Applicants must have maintained a "B" average or better in high school.
4. Applicants must have earned, or be in the process of earning, a total of four sports letters during their junior and senior year.
5. Applicants must submit a handwritten 250-word essay. This must include a brief autobiography, and state the career or profession he/she has chosen and the reasons for making this choice.
6. The recipients will be chosen by a committee of FCHS faculty and the family of Jarod James Dial.

In the event either of the recipients does not complete fall registration for the college or university of his/her choice, the scholarship check will be forfeited.

Applications may be downloaded from the Guidance website. The application and essay must be returned to the Guidance Office by the local scholarship deadline.

The scholarship winner will be announced at Senior Awards Night.
